

Construction of a residential new-build in lightweight concrete at Christinenstraße 39 in Berlin-Mitte

This residential building on Christinenstraße is a monolith cast from concrete on site. The floor-by-floor structure of the building takes elements from its environment and allows the building to express itself in a unique, confident manner. The exciting interiors and an outer form of the building are due to the irregular nature of the plot. The subtle colour of this new-build fits into the Wilhelminian construction very naturally. At the same time, the building defines itself by its wide window openings and the visible solidity of the material. The façades were constructed using a lightweight modern concrete, Liapor, which is load-bearing and offers high thermal insulation.

» Ägyptische Botschaft

In the period from November 2009 to August 2010, we undertook extensive work to convert, extend and add an extra floor to the Egyptian Embassy in Berlin-Tiergarten, without interrupting daily embassy business. Our work involved turnkey completion of the property, in particular the construction of an additional storey to accommodate a residential unit for the ambassador. The erection of the new penthouse floor on the roof involved a 600 m² post-and-beam construction with solar-control glazing and sash sun-screen elements. We created a large, accessible roof terrace, a new entrance area and a newly planted roof garden. Inside, we constructed two new lift shafts from the existing underground garage up to the ambassador's residence on the top floor. New, luxurious bathrooms were installed; high-quality natural stone was used for the walls and floors. The conference rooms were fitted with genuine wooden wall panels and fixtures, and included stylish furniture. On the ground floor, a large kitchen, capable of catering for up to 80 persons, was installed. The building's technical installations were completely overhauled and remote-controlled air-conditioning systems were installed for the offices and residential units.

We realised the shell construction work for this 7-storey residential and commercial building, which comprises 54 freehold apartments, 57 parking places and an underground garage, while integrated some existing elements of the property. One of the highlights is the architecturally sophisticated, starkly articulated outer façade, which was realised primarily using reinforced concrete curtain elements. We completed our work in the late autumn of 2009.



» Pergamon Palais

We completed the structural work for this commercial and residential new-build, which is located next to the UNESCO World Heritage site of the Museumsinsel (Museum Island). The building comprises 16 penthouse apartments, office floors and shops, and has a gross floor space of 15,400 m². This building closed one of the last construction spaces in this unique location opposite the Pergamon Museum. The principal's choice of contemporary architecture establishes clear new accents in this historically important neighbourhood. Taking up the historic division of the site into a block structure, the design of the façade, which gives the impression of six individual buildings, mitigates the massive proportions of the complex. In just 8 months, we created a space of 60,400 m³, using around 9,300 m³ of concrete in the process. The volume of the contract for the erection of this 6-storey residential and commercial building, including the underground car park, amounted to € 4.4 million.

We realised the structural work for this architecturally unique (particularly in the courtyard) property in the leafy district of Berlin-Treptow for an association of principals. The structural work for this 7-storey, ellipse-shaped residential building was characterised by special formwork requirements and property-specific solutions.

The structural work for this architect-designed house, which is characterised by its exposed concrete design, was a real test for our reinforced concrete expert. Each external wall was realised in exposed concrete quality SB 3. The balconies and the spacious entrance area were also realised in concrete. This was only possible with the greatest of expertise and in constant coordination with the formwork material suppliers. The architect had a special wish with regard to the formwork surface structure for the interior of the building: this meant that special matrices had to be produced to realise the desired reinforced concrete structure.

>> Wallstraße Berlin-Mitte

We were responsible for the structural work on this 7-storey residential building, which comprises 23 high-quality residential units and underground parking. The U-Bahn train tracks directly in front of the property meant that sound-proofing was a particular challenge. The principal was entirely satisfied by our construction: we fulfilled the stipulations of both cost-efficiency and the use of architecturally sophisticated reinforced concrete surfaces. The courtyard-side reinforced concrete balconies create a fantastic line of sight.

Our work was obviously good, as it led to a subsequent turnkey project from the principal for the next phase of construction on Grünberger Straße.



» Wohnen am Konsulat

We constructed a residential quarter with Mediterranean flair in Berlin-Pankow / Niederschönhausen.

The apartments are a modern example for urban life with all comforts. We used 2,800 m² of filigree ceilings, 1,100 m² of site-mixed concrete ceilings, 1,500 m³ of ready-mixed concrete, 900 m³ of masonry, 300 tonnes of reinforcement and 24 prefabricated staircases. This turnkey new-build, which comprises 22 residential units and underground parking, was handed over to the owners after just over a year of construction work.

4-star deluxe

» Andel's Hotel Berlin

After 8 years of construction standstill at Landsberger Allee / corner of Storkower Str. in Berlin-Lichtenberg, the German-Austrian joint venture company UBX 1 Berlin GmbH constructed a 4-star deluxe hotel out of the ruins of a concrete building originally designed by Aldo Rossi. We were responsible for the entire structural work from August 2007 until February 2009. 30,500 m² of wall and ceiling formwork, 6,130 m³ of ready-mixed concrete, 750 tonnes of reinforcement steel and 2,230 m³ of masonry were used in around 85,650 working hours to create Berlin's third-largest hotel (500 rooms).

»» Unter den Linden

This previously divided building complex stretches from Unter den Linden to the parallel road of Mittelstraße in the heart of the capital in Berlin-Mitte, and contains two connected inner courtyards. Our company realised the complete structural redevelopment of this building complex, which included adding storeys and constructing both a new underground car park and a new 7-storey intermediate reinforced concrete building. The lift shafts, staircases, marble ballroom, strongroom and parts of the façade were expanded, converted and completely modernised in accordance with monument protection legislation.

We constructed 27 individual residential units and underground parking, where the districts of Berlin-Mitte and Kreuzberg meet on a former section of the Berlin wall. The floor plan solutions for this 7-storey new-build, which were tailored to the buyer, presented us with a unique challenge, particularly with regard to the quality of the concrete surface. Between October 2010 and May 2011 we used 311 tonnes of reinforcing steel.
